Applicant confirms that it i) meets Enbridge's eligibility criteria for public funding assistance, and ii) intends to fully participate in the Program. Applicant acknowledges that any financial incentives are conditional upon its successful completion of the Program and compliance with all applicable terms and conditions. Applicant further acknowledges that its participation in the Program represents a substantial financial commitment on the part of Enbridge and Applicant confirms that should it fail to fully participate in the Program or should it withdraw from the Program prior to its completion, not only will Applicant forfeit any and all financial incentives but Applicant agrees to reimburse Enbridge for all costs incurred by Enbridge which are directly associated with Applicant's participation in the Program.

Terms and Conditions: Affordable Housing New Construction Program (Building Permit)

The following Terms and Conditions apply to Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s ("Enbridge") Affordable Housing New Construction Program (the "Program"). **By signing this application on the reverse side, the applicant certifies that i) it meets the program Eligibility requirements; ii) the information supplied on this application is true and correct; iii) it has read and Understands the program documents; and iv) it agrees to abide by the program rules and to be bound by the Program documents and these general terms and conditions.**

1. The multi-residential buildings (Part 3 as defined by the Ontario Building Code) program consists of four (4) components:

- i. **Plan Review** The Applicant will provide copies of its design plans including mechanical, electrical and lighting drawings and specifications, if available, to Enbridge and its consultants for review and analysis.
- ii. **Design Charrette** The Design Charrette is a building design team meeting to identify the optimal mix of design elements and technologies to maximize energy efficiency for a Part 3 (as defined by the Ontario Building Code) multi-residential building. Enbridge will cover the majority of third party costs associated with the Design Charrette. In exchange for its participation and to offset the cost of incremental professional consulting fees, the Applicant is eligible to receive a Technical Assistance Incentive of **up to \$7,500**.
- iii. **Energy Efficiency Design Implementation ("EEDI")** Depending on the number of units and the achieved energy performance of the Part 3 multi-residential building once constructed, the Applicant is eligible to receive an EEDI Incentive of **up to a maximum of \$120,000**.

- iv. **Commissioning** A building Commissioning Incentive of up to \$15,000 is available to Program participants who meet and complete the above three requirements and who submit their final "as-built" energy model together with the final commissioning report to Enbridge.

The single family housing (Part 9 as defined by the Ontario Building Code) Program consists of three (3) components:

- i. **Plan Review** The Applicant will provide copies of its design plans including mechanical, electrical and lighting drawings and specifications, if available, to Enbridge and its consultants for review and analysis.
 - ii. **Design Charrette** The Design Charrette is a building design team meeting to identify the optimal mix of design elements and technologies to maximize energy efficiency. Enbridge will cover the majority of third party costs associated with the Design Charrette. In exchange for its participation and to offset the cost of incremental professional consulting fees, the Applicant is eligible to receive a Technical Assistance Incentive of up to \$7,500.
 - iii. **Energy Efficiency Design Implementation ("EEDI")** At building completion, a one-time incentive-payment of \$5,000 will be paid to an Applicant who has designed Part 9 (as defined by the Ontario Building Code) single-family housing units to meet the requirements of the Energy Star for New Homes program. In addition, the Applicant is eligible to receive \$1,500 for each residential housing unit that receives an Energy Star for New Homes certification, up to a maximum of \$120,000 per project.
2. In order to be eligible for either Program and Receive Incentives, the Applicant must:
- (a) Be located in the Enbridge Gas franchise area.
 - (b) Meet all eligibility criteria for public housing assistance under the Federal/Provincial Investment in Affordable Housing Program (IAH), the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) or other government funding programs that Enbridge deems suitable as supporting the construction of affordable housing.
 - (c) Complete and submit a fully signed Application to Enbridge and be accepted into the Program by Enbridge.
 - (d) Successfully complete each of the components of the Program within five (5) years of completing the Design Charrette for multi-residential projects, or within three (3) years of completing the Design Charrette for single family housing projects; and
 - (e) Participate in a measurement and evaluation study for the purpose of analyzing the Program's performance and improving future Program designs.

3. Enbridge's offer of Incentive Payments may be withdrawn, in full or part, by Enbridge at any time and will be withdrawn if: the Applicant fails to fully meet the eligibility criteria or fails to fully participate in each of the respective components of the Program including attending all meetings or the Applicant otherwise fails to comply with any of these General Terms and Conditions.

4. The Applicant acknowledges that as a participant in the Program, it will be exchanging or developing ideas with Enbridge and its employees and contractors and will be provided with information from, employees or contractors of Enbridge (the "Information"). You hereby grant to Enbridge and its employees and contractors a non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-transferable license to use any Information owned, licensed, or disclosed by you solely for the purpose of the Program. Enbridge hereby grants you a non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-transferable license to use any Information owned, licensed, or disclosed by Enbridge or its contractors and permission to disclose and share such Information freely with others.

You acknowledge and agree that Information provided to you will be provided on an "as is" basis and that all representations, warranties, and conditions, whether express or implied, with regard to that Information are hereby expressly disclaimed. You acknowledge and agree that you bear all risks associated with your use of Information and Enbridge will in no way be liable to you or anyone in any manner whatsoever for your use of the Information, including, without limitation, if your use of Information infringes any third-party intellectual property rights.

5. Applicant acknowledges that participation in the Program is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Enbridge has the right to refuse an application or to cancel the Program or any part thereof at any time without notice.

6. The Applicant permits Enbridge to identify the Applicant and the Applicant's building as an, "Affordable Housing New Construction Program Participant" and permits Enbridge to identify Applicant in its marketing and communications materials related to the Program.

7. Upon request and with reasonable notice, the Applicant agrees to provide authorized representatives of Enbridge with

(i) access to the building and housing units, and

(ii) required information or data relating to the Program for the purposes of the Application and these General Terms and Conditions.

8. The Applicant acknowledges that Enbridge shall not be responsible for the Applicant's tax consequences resulting from the payment of any incentive payment.

9. **The applicant bears the entire risk of liability, loss, damages, costs and expenses which it may suffer, sustain or incur as a result of participation in the program. The applicant acknowledges that Enbridge does not guarantee that participation in the program will result in any energy savings or qualify for an incentive payment. The applicant shall indemnify and save harmless Enbridge, its directors, officers, agents and employees against any claim or liability arising as a result of or from or based on the applicant's participation in this program or the violation of any applicable laws, whether by the applicant, its officers, employees, subcontractors, representatives or agents.**

10. Enbridge and the Applicant acknowledge and agree that they are independent of one another, and these General Terms and Conditions do not give either of them the right to bind the other to any obligation, or to assume or to incur any obligation on behalf of the other. Nothing in these General Terms and Conditions shall be interpreted so as to make either the Applicant or Enbridge a partner, joint venture, employee, agent or other representative of the other for any purpose.

11. The Application and these General Terms and Conditions shall constitute the entire agreement and understanding between the Applicant and Enbridge and supersedes all previous agreements and understandings between them related to the subject matter hereof. Except as otherwise provided in the Application or these General Terms and Conditions, neither the Applicant or Enbridge is relying on any representation, warranty, conditions, inducement, promise or other assurance (express or implied) which may have been made previously by the other or by anyone else concerning the subject matter hereof. These General Terms and Conditions will be binding upon and enure to the benefit of the parties, and their respective successors and assigns.
